




Geographical location of Shiraz -

- ➤ Iran's capital for several times, the last one being during Zand Dynasty (1749-1779)







> Population: 1.8 million, the 5th most populous city in the country

- ➤ Housing the Seat of Iran's Government in the 18<sup>th</sup> century A.D.








Historical Gates of historical zone of Shiraz







Map of the Historical zone of Shiraz


# Regeneration of Zandiyeh Complex


- ➤ The project covers an area of 30 hectares (0.3 km2), equal to %10 of the whole historical fabric
- It constitutes the Citadel and the surrounding area, which used to function as one of the fundamental structures of Old Shiraz.
- ➤ It involves conservation and restoration projects as well as regeneration and rehabilitation ones.



Spatial Provision for Reviving the Ceremonial Drum Performance During National and Religious Events



- To maintain harmony in the southern, eastern, and northern facades of the Nagareh Khaneh Square, a portico-like space is planned. In the southern and eastern facades, commercial units can be constructed at a depth of 4 meters within the portico.




In the northern side of the square, only porticos are proposed. Commercial units can be designed within the proposed multifunctional uses located on the northern side and connected to the Nagareh Khaneh Square.

#### Weaknesses:


